Please be prepared to present the following:

- Team roster (included in booklet or online) with names of all players and their numbers, official coaching staff (as listed on affidavit) and League President, as they would like to be announced (request this prior to arrival as noted on roster page).
- Team's affidavit package signed and approved by your league President and District Administrator (D7 Staff will review the Affidavit and keep it until the end of the team's participation). The Affidavit "book" (with proofs) will be returned to the Manager.
- Medical Release forms (2 copies) for each player on your roster (we will retain one set)
- Your District Championship Flag/Banner (this will be needed for the Opening Ceremonies)

OPENING CEREMONY

Ceremonies will begin at 4:30 pm (4 pm show time) at McReynolds Athletic Complex (MAC) Field 1, 412 Sports Way, Yorktown, VA 23692 All teams must be at the MAC Field 1 at 4pm, in jerseys (and shorts/pants, full uniform is not required) and hat/visor, bring your District Champion or Representative flag/banner to display as teams are introduced.

Opening Ceremony Agenda and Processes:

- All teams need to arrive by 4pm for a 4:30pm start.
- Teams will be escorted to the Field 1 entry gates to be announced as the ceremony begins.
- Ceremony will begin with team intros beginning with the 9-11 Teams followed by the LL (Majors) Teams, National Anthem, LL Pledge(s), and comments/first pitch.
- NOTE: VA State Association voted to discontinue Opening Ceremony Picnics at all state tournaments after 2023. The concessions will not be open during Opening Ceremonies, however there will be water available. There are numerous eating establishments in the local area.
- After Opening Ceremonies (approximately 6pm) there will be a Movie event for all teams and families at the Peninsula Community Chapel (PCC), 4209 Big Bethel Road, Yorktown, VA 23693. We will be showing "A League of Their Own" on big screens, with free Popcorn and Drinks provided. There is also a large playground on site for younger siblings (closes after dark).
- Manager/Coach/Umpire meeting will be held following opening ceremonies (approximately 6:30pm); Same place as registration/affidavit review and Movie Event. Peninsula Community Chapel (PCC), 4209 Big Bethel Road, Yorktown, VA 23693
- Pin Trading: First opportunities will be at Opening Ceremonies and Movie Event after Opening Ceremonies but available throughout the tournament.

PRE-TOURNAMENT MEETING

The <u>mandatory</u> meeting for all managers, coaches, tournament officials and umpires, will be held following opening ceremonies (approximately 6:30pm) in the same place as registration/affidavit review and Movie Event (Peninsula Community Chapel (PCC), 4209 Big Bethel Road, Yorktown, VA 23693). All official Little League tournament rules will be strictly enforced throughout the tournament. Tournament rules state that the home team will be determined by the toss of a coin. The first day's game coin tosses will be held at the pre-tournament meeting. If the format is Pool Play, all games played during the PP segment will also be conducted. All other game coin tosses will be conducted as soon as both managers have arrived on site by the Tournament Director, or designated individual. The format (Pool Play/Double Elimination) for the tournament is determined based on the number of teams in each tournament and as specified in Little League Rules and Regulations. Drawing for pools/draws were randomly selected in accordance with the VA State Little League Association By-laws at the State Association meeting.

EQUIPMENT

Each team is responsible for bringing/providing their own equipment. Teams will ensure all equipment used during tournament time are in safe, good condition and meets all Little League standards. If issues arise, we will do whatever can be done to help resolve the issue by either loaning equipment or directing your team to a local sporting goods store.

NOTE: Beginning 2025, Little League established that Umpires will <u>not</u> conduct equipment checks prior to regular season or tournament games as in previous years. It is SOLELY the responsibility of the team Manager. We strongly encourage you have your team's equipment inspected by your league or district UIC prior to arriving at this tournament. <u>The penalty for using illegal equipment is extreme.</u> If you have any questions on any player's equipment, please let us know before use so we can avoid any unnecessary penalties.

PRACTICES

We have several practice fields available during daylight hours, first come first served. However, they may not be near the tournament fields. A schedule will be available during registration, and open slots during the week can be worked through the D7 staff. There are not batting cages at the tournament location, however there are batting cages at other nearby facilities we can make available upon request, first come first served basis.

Additionally, D-BAT Newport News has provided 50% off One Hour Team Cage Rentals throughout the tournament, and coupons will be provided at registration. See the flyer at the back of this packet.

Items of interest

Administration Fee

There is not an Administration Fee for these tournaments.

Parking

There is ample parking at the tournament location. There is parking for RVs at the rear of the complex, however there <u>is not</u> overnight parking.

Seating

There are bleachers available at all fields, however, feel free to have your spectators bring lawn chairs to stage around the fields. It's going to be hot, but in the consideration of other spectators, please do not bring umbrellas, shades, or similar items unless they can be set-up and secured without interfering with other spectators. Be advised, there is very little shade at the fields. Spectators (and personal recording devices) will be not be allowed behind and to the side of the backstop so plan accordingly.

Food and Concessions

We have a full array of food, beverage, snack and candy items for sale in the concession stand at a reasonable price (see menu at the back of this packet). There will also be some coffee and ice drinks vendors on site during the tournament.

Fresh drinking water for the players and coaches will be available before during and after the games in each dugout.

Spirit Wear T-Shirts and Apparel

We have teamed with SIMAX Customizable Event Apparel. See brochure in this packet to order online or visit the SIMAX tent onsite. Note: There will not be premade t-shirts onsite for purchase.

Photography

A photographer team will be taking live shots and team photographs for purchase.

Pets

Pets are not allowed at the Tournament Location, MAC. Only service animals are allowed on the premises. This is a county ordinance, and you will be asked to remove your pet if not obeyed.

Smoking/Vaping

Smoking (or vaping) is not permitted in the McReynolds Athletic Complex (MAC). This is a county ordinance, you will be asked to leave the complex.

Streaming Devices

No equipment associated with parental streaming of games may be affixed to any location on the playing facility including light stanchions and fencing. Equipment regardless of whether or not affixed to the fence will not be permitted behind the backstop. If a parent wishes to stream a game, it must be viewed through a personal social media account for private use only and may not be on the open internet in accordance with Little League policy.

Emergencies and Medical Care

*** Call 911***

York County security and emergency units are aware of the tournament schedule and are actively involved with the event preparation. Police, Fire, EMT, and County Officials will be actively participating in this event.

Hydrate, Hydrate!

Lightning

Our area is prone to afternoon thunderstorms especially in summertime. District 7 and York County officials require the fields to be evacuated (and seek cover in a building or vehicles) at the first sound of thunder or flash of lightning. There is a 30 minute wait after the last sound of thunder before returning to the fields. The York County Officials and the District team will use the available weather apps to make weather safety decisions. Please abide by the Tournament Director and Your County Officials instructions. We will communicate through the team managers on resumption of activities.

CODE OF CONDUCT

We expect that all spectators are here to cheer on their favorite All-Star, but sometimes we get a little overzealous. Please be considerate of others.

- Drugs, alcohol, smoking, and foul language is prohibited within the local proximity of the complex.
- Pets are not allowed within the complex.
- Noise makers are prohibited from use at any Virginia State Little League tournament. If you cannot make the noise by using only the parts of your body, please refrain from its use, or you will be asked to leave.
- Walk-up music is not allowed.
- Please contact the Tournament Administrators with any issues.
